THE CHRISTIAN YEAR

I. Christmas-time

The Season of Advent

The Christian Year begins with the 1st Sunday in Advent. "Advent" means the "coming", "arrival" of Jesus Christ on Christmas.

This season has four Sundays. It has a penitential character in preparation for Christmas, the feast of the birth of Jesus Christ. This character is liturgically expressed by the violet colour and by the omission of "The Act of Praise" and the "Hallelujah Verse" and the "Hallelujah Chorus", which are replaced by a "Responsory" especially for this season of Advent.

The Season of Christmas

On 25th December the Church celebrates the "Nativity of Christ".

It is preceded by a vigil service on the eve before or in the night between 24th/25th December.

In order to celebrate this great event of salvation history extensively enough, a 2nd Christ-mas Day on 26th December is added.

This season may have up to eight Sundays after Christmas, depending on the feast of Easter, whether it falls early, then it shortens this season, or it falls later, then it lengthens it. While 3rd to 7th Sunday after Christmas may drop out due to this rule, the Last Sunday after Christmas is always celebrated as feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord.

The liturgical colour of this whole season is white.

II. Easter-time

The Season before Lent

Before Lent proper, there are **three Sundays before Lent** with **green** as liturgical colour.

The Season of Lent

It begins with **Ash Wednesday** in the week of Next Sunday before Lent and ends on Holy Saturday evening.

It is a period of 40 days, Sundays not counted, of preparation towards Holy Week and Easter, by acts of penitence, intensive prayer and fasting. No joyous feasting, especially no marriages are celebrated. In the liturgy "The Act of Praise" is omitted, with the exception of the Main Service on Holy Thursday. No "Hallelujah" is sung. There is a special "Responsory" for Lent instead. No flowers are put in churches. **The liturgical colour is violet**, with the exception of the Main Service on Holy Thursday which has white, and Good Friday and Holy Saturday which have black.

With the 6th Sunday in Lent, **Palm Sunday, Holy Week begins** with its climax of the Holy Three days, **Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday**.

The Season of Easter

The **Easter Vigil**, in the very early morning, opens the Easter celebrations. **Easter Sunday and Easter Monday** are followed by six Sundays after Easter.

The Thursday between 5th and 6th Sunday after Easter, the Church celebrates **Ascension Day**, 40 days after Easter.

The liturgical colour is **white** throughout.

The Easter season ends 50 days after Easter with Pentecost, its liturgical colour is **red**.

III. The Time after Pentecost

The Season after Pentecost

This season varies in length. If Easter is early, this season is longer; if Easter is late, it is shorter. That means some of the 25 Sundays after Pentecost can drop out; affected can be 21st to 25th Sundays after Pentecost.

The 1st Sunday after Pentecost is the **Sunday of the Holy Trinity**. Its liturgical colour is **white**.

The liturgical colour for the rest of this season is **green**; only **Reformation Day** and **All Saints' Day** have **red**.

The Season before Advent

Before Advent there are **three Sundays** with **green** as liturgical colour and special themes:
3rd Sunday before Advent = "**Creation**", 2nd Sunday before Advent = "**The Fall**", Next Sunday before Advent = "**Death**".

Presbyterian Church Day, however, occupies either the 3rd or 2nd Sunday before Advent every year. Its liturgical colour is **red**.

With **Saturday** in the week of **Next Sunday before Advent** the Christian year ends.

Note has to be taken in view of the use of liturgical colours thus:
The use of liturgical colours is ruled and determined by the seasons of the "Christian Year", never by the rank of the presiding minister, and also not by the occasion, with only the following few exceptions:
WHITE for "Memorial Services" and "the Dedication of a burial ground",
VIOLET for "A penitential service for General confession",
BLACK for "Burial services",
RED for "Services of the Synod", "The Ordination to the Ministry of Word and Sacraments", "The Institution and Induction of the moderator", The dedication of a Church.

INTRODUCTION TO THE VARIOUS BIBLE READINGS

Sunday Readings

For the current 2019/2020 Church Year the Introit Psalms, Lessons and Texts for the Sundays, Holy Days and special Days are taken from Year A of THE CALENDAR AND LECTIONARY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH IN CAMEROON; those of the Church Year 2020/2021, which starts on 1st December, are taken from Year B.

The "Introit Psalm" is that Psalm which is sung by the choir or, second best, read by the worship leader during the entrance procession, **but not after from the Lord's Table!** If for any reason this Psalm was not used during this Entry Procession, it may be sung or read between the 1st and 2nd lesson later on in the service. **Any divine service starts with "The Salutation"**, not with a Psalm!

Since **Harvest Thanksgiving** never falls on a fixed date, but is always arranged locally, no provision has been made for it in the diary. Therefore, whenever and wherever Harvest Thanksgiving is celebrated (launching only!), the proper and lessons and text for the Sunday given in the diary are replaced by the proper for Harvest Thanksgiving and the following Introit Psalm, Lessons and Text:

Introit Psalm 65: 1-2 & 9-13
1st Lesson Lk. 12: 15-21
2nd Lesson Heb. 13:14-16
Text Dt. 26: 1-11

Liturgical Colour: Green or colour of the season.

Weekday Readings

As to the daily Bible reading, there are three passages provided for each day:

- The first passage is in most cases related to the lessons and text of the previous Sunday or Holy Day, and thus unfolds their meaning during the week. Therefore, these first passages in a week are also interrelated with each other.
- Those who want to read the Bible more extensively and continuously should also read the second and third passages. The second one leads the faithful reader through the main parts of the Old Testament, and the third one through the whole of the New Testament within a period of three years.

Note to the Readers

Avoid this error when reading Lessons:

How do you read this passage: 1 Jn. 1: 5- 2: 6 ?

It doesn't mean you read 1 Jn. 1: 5, then you jump to go and read chapter 2: 6.

No! read the whole passage from 1 Jn. 1: 5 to chapter 2: 6 without skipping any verse.
